

A blurb about Follow Me:

Following Jesus is a lifelong journey where we learn and do what Jesus said and did. It takes more than the head, checking off boxes of belief. It even takes more than the heart, feeling deeply about another person or a cause. Following Jesus is about these things and more. It is also about doing. And it takes practice. And practice. And more practice. We are not practicing for perfection, however, but practicing to put faith and love into action. As we explore faith practices, we are diving into the essence of what makes us Christian, those who follow the one who practiced what he preached!

How does it work?

The whole church will explore the same faith practice each week. Worship will enhance what is explored in weekly classes. Each faith practice will be explored for a month.

September: Welcome All (Hospitality)

October: Follow Jesus

November: Confess

How are the Classes Divided?

Adults: Cafe' Conversations in the Memorial Room

Share a cup of something hot (choose coffee, tea, cider, hot cocoa), as we explore the topic. Questions and diverse beliefs are encouraged.

Faithful Follower TOTS (ages 2-5) and CHILDREN (6-10) in the Education Wing

Play, cook, do art, spend time in nature, hear Bible stories, enjoy music and movement, and take part in dramas. Multiple teachers who specialize in each area will work with our kiddos to make the program full of joyful learning!

Faithful Follower YOUTH (ages 11-18) in the Reception Hall Library

Grow in faith using numerous mediums, including tech, to explore faith practices. This is a safe place to ask questions, challenge social norms, and be supported.




